

- 8. Menu will appear on left side
- 9. Click/touch 'Academy'
- 10. Scroll down to and click/touch 'obedience'
- 11. Click/touch box 'View All Assessments'
- 12. See box Requirements of Obedience Judge exam
- 13. Click/touch 'Assessment details'
- 14. When ready, click/touch box 'Begin Assessment'

TIPS & INFORMATION FOR JUDGES

- When possible, provide your own stewards.
- Always keep the show management up to date with any changes to your team.
- Remember you can't judge more than six Open Class C's in a calendar year
- Take a spare set of retrieve articles in case your originals are not appropriate (e.g. If they are not visible in long grass).
- Take a spare sendaway marker in case of accident.
- Keep competitors up to date during the day by completing the main scoreboard at regular intervals
- Have your sendaway up in good time before judging starts so that early runners are not disadvantaged
- Take regular breaks, you are entitled to enjoy your day!!
- You must remain in the ring and observe the dog and handler at all times, including during training rounds.

• Scent Cloths MUST be placed in position by a steward and MUST be at least 1m (3ft) and not more than 1.6m (5ft) apart


